Dear Parent,

AVN Vida School infuses the child with the spirit of camaraderie, cohesion and competitiveness. Each child from grade 1 onwards is initiated into the house system and is placed in a House and is gradually introduced to the ethos of the institution.

The main function of the house system is to develop a sense of identity or belonging and to celebrate achievements.

It is important for students to have the opportunity to play an active role and contribute to a community within their school, which allows them to develop skills and talents and acknowledges their successes in a wide range of ways.

We encourage students to play an active role in the success of their house. Individual and team efforts are rewarded and students are expected to contribute to Inter-house competitions throughout the year.

We host a number of events throughout the year to exercise enjoyment of friendly competition. These include; sports days, monthly competitions, spelling bees, Olympiad exams, art and craft challenges etc., House points will be awarded based on the above events. The aim of the house system is to inculcate and develop the qualities of leadership, public speaking & organizational skills among the students through various inter house competitions and school functions.
