Subject: Social studies


ACTIVITY-

Grade V

Subject: Science

ACTIVITY- Science Lab Activity

Students went to science lab to explore what are solutions and mixtures. Teacher showed them how to make sugar solution and what are the components of solution. She explained them, in this solution sugar is a solute and water is a solvent. Teacher made a mixture with water and sand in a glass and explained the difference between solution and mixture. She explained them the separation methods like hand picking, sieving, filtration and evaporation. Students explore the filtration method for separating sand and water mixture using filter paper. The learning outcome of this activity was that students will understand how a solution looks, what are its components. They will understand the difference between solution and mixture. Students will be able to use separation methods to separate mixtures in their daily life .



Grade VI

Subject: Science

ACTIVITY- Writing and speaking activity on Components of food.

Students of grade 6 A & Damp; B have written about topic components of food. In their project they have written what are the nutrients present in food like Carbohydrate, Fats, Proteins, Vitamins and minerals. They wrote about role of these nutrients in our body and their sources. They drew food pyramid and wrote about that. In class, they gave a presentation of their project. The learning outcome of this activity is that with this presentation student will know the components of food,

sources of these nutrients and their usefulness in our body. In their daily routine they will make sure to add all the nutrients in their diet. Students will understand the benefits of eating balanced diet.
